



The Morton Museum of Collierville History and the Collierville Arts Council specially invites employees of Town of Collierville to submit original artworks for consideration in a group show featuring art by employees of the Town from August 21 – October 23, 2017. Two dimensional exhibitions will be displayed on wall hooks and three dimensional exhibitions (ex. sculptures) will be displayed on secured pedestals. All work must come with required support materials (artist statements, label copy, etc.). Artworks will be exhibited for a 10 week period at Collierville Town Hall. The number of works in the show will be determined by size and number of submissions received. Artists are urged to submit their entries as early as possible for consideration.

### Specifications for Exhibited Work

1. No one dimension shall exceed 48 inches for 2D work and 15 inches for 3D work.
2. All work must be original, no reproductions allowed.
3. Must be a current employee of the Town of Collierville.
4. Artists selected will be responsible for mounting, matting, and framing.
  - a. All works should be ready for hanging/display – picture wire should be affixed to the back of the artwork, see link <http://www.cheapjoes.com/catalogsearch/result/?q=wire>. You must have this done prior to drop off.
  - b. All matted artwork must be framed.
5. Artists are responsible for providing related support material for the exhibition:
  - a. 50-100 word Biography
  - b. 50-100 word Artist Statement
  - c. List of work including title, medium, and dimensions.

### Entry Procedures

1. Entries for first round of consideration must be emailed to [museum@ci.collierville.tn.us](mailto:museum@ci.collierville.tn.us) by **June 13, 2017**. After June 13, 2017, entries are encouraged and will be considered on a rolling basis.  
Information to include with submission:
  1. Artist Name
  2. Mailing Address
  3. Phone Number
  4. Email
  5. Five Sample Artwork Entries represented by a jpeg digital image with a minimum 300 dpi and include: title, dimensions, medium and support (example: Oil on Linen).
  6. 50-100 words explaining the theme of your show.

### Notification

1. All submitting artists will be notified by e-mail of selection decisions.
2. Artwork is selected based on a complete application package, artistic quality and design, creativity and originality, suitability of display, and audience appeal.
3. The Morton Museum and Collierville Arts Council reserves the right not to display any selected work that does not correspond to the quality or configuration indicated in the submitted images.
4. Artwork delivery instructions will be sent with selection notification.
