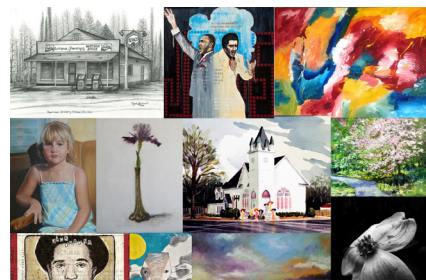
Making a Town: Collierville Railroad History
